2010-2011 VPK Provider Rate

The VPK Provider Kindergarten Readiness Rate measures how well a VPK provider prepares four-year olds to be ready for kindergarten based on the Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards for Four-Year Olds (ECHOS) and The Broad Screen/Progress Monitoring portion of the Florida Assessments for Instruction in Reading (FAIR). The Broad Screen consists of Letter Naming and Phonemic Awareness tasks.

Children included in the rate:

- were in attendance for at least 70- percent of either the School Year or Summer VPK program (have substantially completed the program)
- have screening results on ECHOS and FAIR.

The Maximum 2010-11 readiness rates is 100 this is a change from the previous 200 point scale.

(Summer Program) 100 out of 100



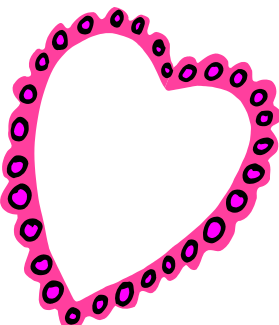
Shriners Hospitals for Children Teddy Bear Drive

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Lemony Love Potion Treat

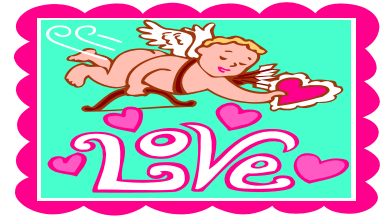
Ingredients
